Presentations in blocks – keep the idea as the principle is good. Scorers will need to have a runner to go to the Referee to get results signed so they are ready to read out at the completion of the last event of the block.

Don't put results up on the board until the end of a block.

Some flippant, lippy remarks were made to Referees from skaters. Skaters need to remember that the Referee deserves respect and skaters need to treat officials with respect.
