POLICY 05.

NEW ZEALAND TEAM SELECTION POLICY - WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Representative international artistic teams will be selected from judged competition (selection event/s) as decided by the NZFRS Artistic Roller Sports Committee. Only those skaters who meet the selection criteria at the time of selection will be named in the team.

Skaters are encouraged to compete in Oceania Championships and other suitable international competitions (which includes Australian Nationals).

Three Selectors consisting of the World Team Coach and two International Judges from the selection event judging panel, will provide a written report to the NZFRS Artistic Roller Sports Committee confirming that the selection criteria requirements noted below were met by the nominating skaters. Those selected will be approved by the NZFRS Artistic Roller Sports Committee and ratified by the NZFRS Board.

A nomination fee which includes a deposit is to be paid with the completed nomination form. For successful selections, the deposit will be credited to the skater's World team account. This amount is non-refundable. Unsuccessful nominations will result in a refund of the deposit.

The number of skaters representing New Zealand will be determined by the World Skate ATC entry procedure policy as at the date of the selection event.

Senior Free Skating and Figures:

- Countries in the first 10th places in the previous year can enter three (3) skaters.
- Countries placing 11th to 20th inclusive in the previous year can enter two (2) skaters.
- Countries placing 21st and below in the previous year can enter one (1) skater.
- If the country has not participated in the last World Championships in a particular event, it will be allowed to enter just one (1) skater in that event.

Senior Solo Dance and Junior Figures, Free Skating, and Solo Dance:

- Countries in the first 20th places in the previous year can enter two (2) skaters.
- Countries from 21st and below in the previous year can enter one (1) skater.
- If the country has not participated in the last World Championships, it will be allowed to enter just one (1) skater.

Each member National Federation may enter, for Seniors events, a maximum of three (3) teams in each of the following events: pairs skating, dance skating. For Juniors events a maximum of two (2) teams of the following: pairs skating, dance skating.

Each member National Federation may enter a maximum of three (3) teams for Precision, three (3) teams for small and large Show, and a maximum of two (2) teams for Quartets events.

CRITERIA

NEW ZEALAND MEDAL TEST QUALIFICATIONS

As set by the NZFRS Artistic Roller Sports Committee for selection

Senior – medal test 8

Junior – medal test 7

Inline – medal test 6

Precision – medal test 6

Small and Large Show – medal test 5 (any artistic or precision medal)

Quartets – medal test 6 (any artistic or precision medal)

Under special circumstances, Cross crediting of medal tests (Artistic to Precision) for individual skaters in a Precision team may be available upon application to and at the discretion of the NZFRS Artistic Roller Sports Committee. Nominations for Precision teams, Small and Large Show groups will be taken from Club teams and composite teams NOT individual skaters.

NEW ZEALAND SELECTION EVENT/S

At the selection event/s the nominees must meet all World Skate elements and requirements for their grade in the competition year.

NEW ZEALAND TEAM SELECTION POLICY – OCEANIA CHAMPIONSHIPS

Representative international artistic teams are to be selected from judged competitive event/s as decided by the NZFRS Artistic Roller Sports Committee. Only those skaters who meet the selection requirements at the time of selection will be named in the team.

Three Selectors consisting of the Oceania Team Coach and two Judges from the selection event judging panel, will provide a written report to the NZFRS Artistic Roller Sports Committee confirming that the selection requirements noted below were met by the nominating skaters. Those selected will be approved by the NZFRS Artistic Roller Sports Committee and ratified by the NZFRS Board.

A nomination fee which includes a deposit is to be paid with the completed nomination form. For successful selections, the deposit will be credited to the skater's Oceania team account. This amount is non-refundable. Unsuccessful nominations will result in a refund of the deposit.

 Junior Oceania team, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th placings from the nominated skaters
 Youth Oceania team, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th placings from the nominated skaters
 Cadet Oceania team, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th placings from the nominated skaters
 Advanced Masters Oceania team, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th placings from the nominated skaters
 Masters Oceania team, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th placings from the nominated skaters
 Inline Oceania team, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th placings from the nominated skaters
 Mini Precision team, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th placings from the nominated teams
 Precision team, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th placings from the nominated teams
 Quartet team, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th placings from the nominated teams
 Small Show group, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th placings from the nominated teams
