Note: The age in the list above refers to the age the skater is turning in the year of the competition (that is, in the calendar year being; 1st of January through to and including the 31st of December).

World Skate rules:

To be eligible to compete in any category, a skater who has competed in the previous year in a higher category must not compete in a lower one after that. In New Zealand the exceptions would be; Advanced Masters, Masters.

Please note that all changes to the requirements have been made in green, but in addition there are a few major changes that we wish to point out:

- The grade for freeskating pairs (not couples dance) can be chosen by the skaters by either the age of the male skater OR the age of the oldest partner, for the 2020 year only.
- **Preliminary** - many categories have had an age reduction to 10 years.
- **Espoir Freeskating** - has a short and long programme now.
- **Advanced Masters and Masters** - all have been separated out as separate events and also there are options regarding being able to compete at different levels, depending on age and medal tests requirements.
- **All figures** - we have adopted the World Skate terminology as follows and updated in the requirements;
 - The previously termed change eight - is now a half eight
 - The previously termed serpentine - is now a change eight
- **Adult grade** - this has replaced Esquire and the age has been lowered, and as announced last year, this is now an Area event only.
- **Show and Precision grades** - These have changed considerably, please refer to this section for full details.

The selection of rhythms used is a minimum of two (2) and a maximum of three (3) different rhythms.

The choice of two (2) rhythms may include the use of two (2) different music selections for the same rhythm, however, this may only be done for one (1) of the selected rhythms. The choice of three (3) different rhythms may NOT include the use of two different music selections for the same rhythm.

One of the selected rhythms must be the rhythm required for the Pattern Dance Sequence.

During the Pattern Dance Sequence, a change of music selection is NOT permitted.

GENERAL RULES

Each team will be permitted thirty (30) seconds for the positioning before the commencement of the performance. Once the team is ready for the music to commence the team captain must raise their hand to advise the announcer.

- Neither portable or handheld props shall be used
- Vocal music shall be permitted
- Costume rules – see Artistic rules and regulations
- **Reserves are required for all precision teams. The minimum required number of members for a precision team will be the minimum number for competition plus 1. i.e. Open Mini Precision = 4-8 members, minimum number for domestic competition will be 5 skaters.**
- The grading of a Precision team is determined by the age of the majority of the skaters. Where the team is evenly split it is to skate in the higher grade.

REGULATIONS FOR CLUB SHOW CHALLENGE

The main emphasis for the Club Show skating challenge will be skating and entertainment value. Participants must be members of the Affiliated Club that is being represented, and a registered member of the New Zealand Federation of Roller Sports (Inc) This membership may be the Class 5 Supporters membership if not already a New Zealand Federation of Roller Sports member.

Entry is allowed direct to the New Zealand Artistic Roller Sports Championships, ie there is no requirement for teams to qualify through Areas.

A team name must be provided on the entry form. At the New Zealand Artistic Roller Sports Championships, a Challenge trophy will be awarded to the winning team.

TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

1. Duration of performance – **minimum 3.30 minutes, maximum 4 minutes**. Time to start with the first movement.
2. A minimum of four (4) skaters of any age.
3. Free skating and Pairs skating are allowed. However, skating will be assessed on the performance of the whole group.
4. There will be no restriction on the choice of music, but skating must be in tune with the music chosen.
5. Movements or steps performed in stationary positions are allowed. However, programmes with excessive stationary movements will be given less credit. Choreography must commence within ten (10) seconds after the music has started.
6. The main performance of a show group must be Show, not Precision. If there are Precision elements, they must be performed in the character of a show.
7. All participants must be on skates.
8. Only handheld or portable props are permitted.
9. Fog machines, water or personal spotlights are not permitted.

MARKING

The event will be judged by two (2) commissioned judges and one (1) invited judge and their decision will be final.

Criteria for evaluation will be:

- a) Creativity
- b) Entertainment

Entry & Exit on the floor:

- A maximum of forty (40) seconds are allowed for entry onto the rink.
- A penalty of up to -0.3 from "A" mark if the entry takes longer than the permitted time may be applied.
- It is Optional to provide:-

A short explanation of not more than twenty five (25) words may be attached to the entry describing the performance. These descriptions will be given to the judges and announced as the group is entering the floor. If you do wish to submit this description it is to be done at the Team Managers' Meeting, along with skaters' name.
