POLICY 04.

The Jack Fanthorpe Memorial Fund.

Money donated by Mrs Vilma Fanthorpe has been set up as a trust fund named the Jack Fanthorpe Memorial Fund. The interest on this is paid to a selected skater each year at the completion of the New Zealand Championships Artistic or Graeme Sheppard Challenge, whichever is the later event.

Criteria.

For the skater who has achieved the most in National and International fields having a sense of commitment to the sport of skating.

Criteria for allocating the fund.

Points will be awarded for placements in the following competitions;

Senior events at New Zealand Championships Artistic Oceania Championships Graeme Sheppard Challenge World Senior Artistic Championships

<u>NOTE</u>: Placings from Australian Nationals, Asian Games or other competitions that skaters or teams are not selected for, from a selection competition, are not included.

Points allocation as follows

1st placement3 points2nd placement2 points3rd placement1 point

NOTE: If only one skater or pair in an event then points allocated to that event will be halved.

In the event of a tie when the points are added at year end, then the money will be shared equally between the skaters with the highest points gained from the above competitions.

The selection of this skater will be done by the above points system which will be kept by Mrs V Fanthorpe during her lifetime, and in event of her being unable to perform this function she nominates Kylie Shirley and she is given full power to nominate her own successor.
