NEW ZEALAND ARTISTIC ROLLER SPORTS COMMITTEE POLICY 10

OFFICIALS AND COACHES SCHOLARSHIP

The NZFRS Artistic Roller Sports Committee has set up a Scholarship to assist new officials and coaches of Artistic Roller Skating. This Scholarship will encourage new officials and coaches to further their knowledge through mentoring programs or attending seminars/events.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR OFFICIALS

- 1. Candidates must be at least 16 years at time of application.
- 2. Officials must hold at least one Class 3 Commission.
- 3. Candidates must be able to show evidence of involvement at Club level, eg. Leagues, Regionals, Medal tests, etc.
- 4. Candidates must have attended all Officials/Coaches Seminars held in New Zealand in the last calendar year.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR COACHES

- 1. Candidates must be at least 16 years at time of application.
- 2. Candidates must have completed the Level 1 Sports Specific Coaching Accreditation Exam.
- 3. Candidates must not have been coaching at National level grades for more than five years.
- 4. Candidates must not have had pupils competing in a World International team.
- 5. Candidates must be able to show evidence of involvement at Club level, eg. Learn to Skate Classes, Leagues, Regionals, Club events, Medal tests, etc.
- 6. Candidates must have attended all Coaches/Officials Seminars held in New Zealand in the last calendar year.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Candidates must supply a written application directly to the Secretary of the NZFRS Artistic Roller Sports Committee.
- 2. Applications must include the Candidates Aspiration/Pathway for a four year period.
- 3. Applications must include a statement of how the scholarship would assist, eg. mentoring programs, attend national/international seminar, etc.
- 4. Applications must include a budget of how the scholarship will be used.
- 5. Applications must include an identification of barriers, if any.
- 6. On completion of the Scholarship, the Candidate must report back to the NZFRS Artistic Roller Sports Committee on the benefits gained within 30 days.
