LUTZ

The content sheet must specify where the skater is attempting a lutz. If lutz isn't written the Technical Specialist will call what they see.

Lutz is the responsibility of the technical panel to call the lutz jumps if the required technical characteristics are fulfilled even if it is not in the content sheet.

If the lutz is in the content sheet but the lutz is a 'flutz' the technical panel will call "lutz no edge" and the system will give the element 50% of it's value and the judges will score accordingly to the guidelines (-2)
