Development squad - We have 7 Learn to skate skaters taking part in the development squad in 2020, this runs over 5 weeks only, this year, as we have had to cut it down due to Alert levels.

Trainee coaches programme Our five Trainees have or are completing - Required First Aid course, Communication skills two modules, Workshop on invoicing, Music cutting, basic business skills, Motivational skills and Team building exercises. 8 Coaches modules with their Lead coach. Competency tests completed 3 with 2 more to complete before then end of 2020. They are also under a Mentoring programme until 2022. We have four new trainees starting in January 2021.

Annual show - December, All skaters take part and this event is open to the public.

Competition in Hamilton for Northern Area skaters -, we have about half our skaters interested in attending this.
