SECTION 1: Application Process

Applicant to approach Secretary of the NZFRS Registered Club for a Recognition Prior Learning/Current Competence (RPL) Workbook. The workbook can be obtained from the NZ Artistic Roller Sports Committee website : www.nzartisticrollersports.co.nz/ under Resources/Coaches' Corner.

NZFRS Registration Fee paid and Current.

Applicant must be a current registered member of New Zealand Federation of Roller Sports Inc (SkateNZ) and a member of an affiliated Club. (Club secretary signing the Application form will confirm the above)

All details in the Workbook must be completed and signed by the Club Secretary. When the workbook is completed by the applicant please forward it to NZAC (NZ Academy of Coaches) with all documents by **email. NZAC artistic.nzac@skatenz.org.nz**. The NZAC (NZ Academy of Coaches) will advise the outcome to the applicant with a copy to the Secretary of the Club concerned.

The Workbook contains all the necessary information to be assessed to submit a Recognition of Prior Learning/Current Competence (RPL) Application through the Club Secretary to the Project Coordinator, NZ Academy of Coaches.
In order to submit this application **ALL** elements **MUST** be completed.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) Application Form

This form asks you to provide information about yourself and the knowledge and skills that are the basis of your application for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL).

The form contains two sections:

SECTION 1: General information about yourself and the specific details of your RPL application.

SECTION 2: Information about how your experience relates to your RPL application.

- A. After completing this application form, you may be invited to attend an interview at which point you will have the opportunity to support your application.
- B. There are many ways that a person can show evidence of current competencies. RPL can only be granted on current evidence, that is, work that has been completed within the last four years and competencies that are currently able to be demonstrated. Following are a few examples of the ways evidence can be provided. You will need to include a variety of these in your application.
- Coaching Related Experiences
 - Education and Training
 - Life Experiences
 - And many more
- C. Payment of the relevant fee is required in full before the application will be assessed. This fee is non-refundable.

- Statements outlining training programs and or study that you have undertaken and the learning outcomes/competencies achieved from these.
- Evidence of home/self-directed study which may include a list of recent readings, synopsis of seminars attended, reports of research or analysis undertaken.

The above are only examples. You should provide all the documents that clearly shows evidence of the competencies you hold.
