NZ Ranking and Selection Policies

The Artistic Committee recently released a NZ Ranking Policy (as required by World Skate) and a re-vamped Selection Policy.

Both of these Policies will be available on the Artistic Website and they have also been sent out to clubs with this News Flash.

The intention behind the changes to the Selection Policy is to create an environment where our current and future international skaters are supported, where NZ team management and NZFRS/Artistic Committee admin have advanced planning time for international events, and where NZ team selection is based on consistency of performance rather than performance at one selection event. The changes will also allow future skaters to base themselves overseas for an extended time, if they so wish, while also allowing for them to be considered for NZ Team selection on the basis of their overseas results.

The Artistic Committee are holding a Zoom session to read through the policies with the NZ Skating community and answer any questions that may arise. This session will take place at **7pm on Saturday the 21st of January** and can be accessed via the following link:
