# WORLD SKATE ACADEMY: ARTISTIC SKATING

World Skate is glad to announce that the World Skate Academy returns for the academic year 2022-2023 and the Online Courses will be available for Artistic Skating Coaches. All information about the Judges courses will be published in the coming weeks.

The Online Courses will be held through a new platform compared to the one used until last academic years. More detailed information on this will be made available shortly.

# COACHES

There will be lessons for World Skate Coaches Level 1, 2 and 3.

#### These lessons are open to everyone.

For Level 1 it is expected that the National Federations propose <u>two coaches</u> for each discipline (Free Skating, Pairs, Dance, Precision) to officially start the process to be recognized as World Skate Coach.

Only those who have already passed level 1 can access level 2 and only those who have passed level 1 and 2 can access level 3.

During the academic year 2022-23 it is possible to reach only one level.

At the end of each level there will be an assessment test that will be necessary to access the next level during the next academic year.

Anyone can attend these lessons but only 2 coaches nominated by their National Federations will be officially recognized as World Skate Coaches.

Eventually up to three coaches will be accepted for those nations where for the vastness of the territory need more places to meet the requirements of the project. The Artistic Technical Commission will analyse each situation and will decide if to approve three coaches instead of two.

The eligible candidates must complete the whole training prepared by World Skate (level 1,2 and 3) and pass the exams in order to be recognized internationally as a World Skate Coach.

The Coaches will have the possibility to present courses at a national level, in their own country, with material provided by World Skate.

Please note that the decision to confirm a nominated coach to participate at the World Skate Academy will be solely up to World Skate. The deadline for the National Federations

to send the names and the information requested of the coach/es to **artistic@worldskate.org** is <u>January 15<sup>th</sup> 2023</u>.

# LESSONS AND SCHEDULE

The training period will begin in February 2023. More details on course availability dates will be published shortly.

All lessons will be pre-recorded and the Participants will be able to attend them on the days and times of their choice. All lessons will be available in both English and Spanish.

# REGISTRATION

Below you can find the first information on the registration process, all the details will be made available shortly.

All Participants will have to register individually and not through the National Federation. The login credentials used on the previous website (Username and Password) will no longer be valid and all Participants will have to register again on the new platform. The link for registration will be made available in a future communication.

The individual payment can be processed directly on the online platform by PayPal or Stripe (using a credit or debit card).

Should National Federations need to pay the courses for their Participants, first they will need to inform us with an email to <u>academy@worldskate.org</u> on which participants and which courses the payment should be made for; then they will be able to process the payment via bank transfer or credit card through a direct link.
