- A. After completing this application form, you may be invited to attend an interview at which point you will have the opportunity to support your application.
- B. There are many ways that a person can show evidence of current competencies. RPL can only be granted on current evidence, that is, work that has been completed within the last four years and competencies that are currently able to be demonstrated. Following are a few examples of the ways evidence can be provided. You will need to include a variety of these in your application.
 - Coaching Related Experiences
 - Education and Training
 - Life Experiences
 - And many more
